Course learning objectives (1)

By the end of the course Level A2, you will be able to:

A. Knowledge

1. Vocabulary: Use the language related to simple and familiar topics,

e.g. jobs, food and drink, everyday activities, routines, etc.

2. Grammar:

- Accurately use countable and uncountable nouns, adverbs of frequency, determiners, common modal verbs, etc.
- Make statements and questions using the present simple, present continuous and past simple.
- Ask questions using the present simple.
- Use phrases and structures to express possession, preference, intentions, wants and wishes.



APPENDIX

Course learning objectives (2)

By the end of the course Level A2, you will be able to:

B. Skills

1. Listening:

- Recognise phrases, content words and expressions related to familiar topics.
- Understand short, basic descriptions of familiar topics and situations, if delivered slowly and clearly.
- Identify basic factual information in short, simple dialogues, narratives or videos on familiar topics, if spoken slowly and clearly.
- Follow short, simple social exchanges.

2. Reading:

- Understand short, simple texts on familiar topics.
- Understand short, simple messages on postcards, emails and social networks.
- Read a simple text and extract factual details.
- Understand the general meaning of short, simple informational material and descriptions if there is visual support.
- Identify key or specific information in short, simple informational texts related to familiar topics.

B. Skills (cont.)

3. Speaking:

- Talk about familiar topics using simple language.
- Take part in a very simple conversation on a familiar topic, provided the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.
- Express intentions, preferences, wishes, offers, requests, and suggestions, etc. using fixed phrases and expressions.

4. Writing:

- Accurately use capital letters, punctuation marks, connectors, etc.
- Write simple sentences on familiar topics, given prompts or a model.
- Write basic personal details for a website profile, business card, etc.
- Write short texts on familiar topics, given a model or using basic fixed expressions.
