





Course learning objectives (1)

By the end of the course Level A1, you will be able to:

A. Knowledge

1. Vocabulary: Use the language related to simple and familiar topics, e.g. work, places, directions, everyday activities, etc.

2. Grammar:

- Use personal pronouns, ordinal numbers, basic prepositions, articles, etc.
- Make statements and questions using the present simple.
- Make simple statements, using common past simple forms.
- Use phrases to express wants, wishes, intentions, etc.

Course learning objectives (2)

By the end of the course Level A1, you will be able to:

B. Skills

1. Listening:

- Recognise words and simple phrases related to familiar topics, if delivered slowly and clearly
- Understand simple sentences spoken slowly and clearly.
- Follow simple, everyday conversations if carried out slowly and clearly.
- Identify simple information in short videos, provided that the visual supports this information and the delivery is slow and clear.

2. Reading:

- Understand words and simple phrases related to familiar topics.
- Understand basic factual statements relating to pictures or simple texts.
- Understand short, simple texts, given visual support.

3. Speaking:

- Accurately repeat clearly spoken words, phrases, and short sentences.

- Write simple sentences on familiar topics.
- Write short, simple notes, emails and postings to friends.
- Write simple texts containing key information, given a model.
